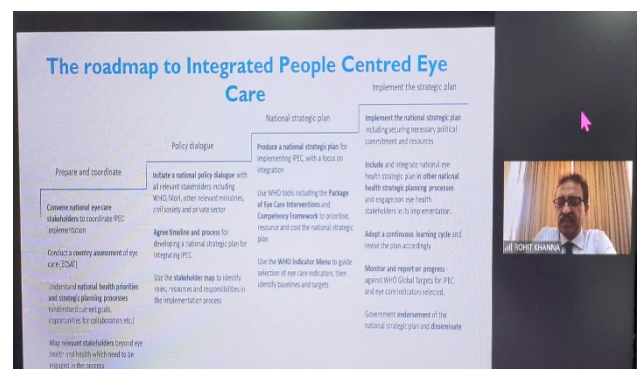
Also, statutory compliances had been met like annual filing to the Society Registrar, executive committee and board meetings.
